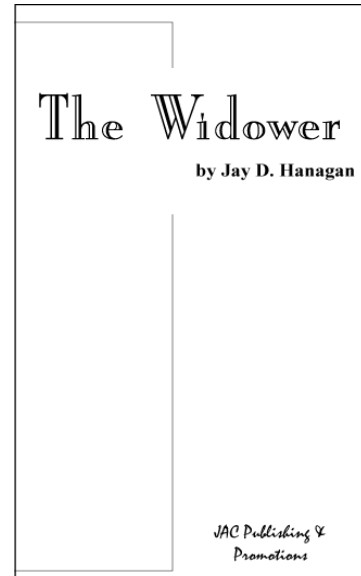
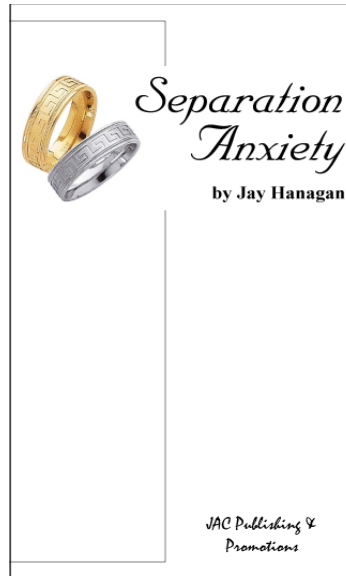
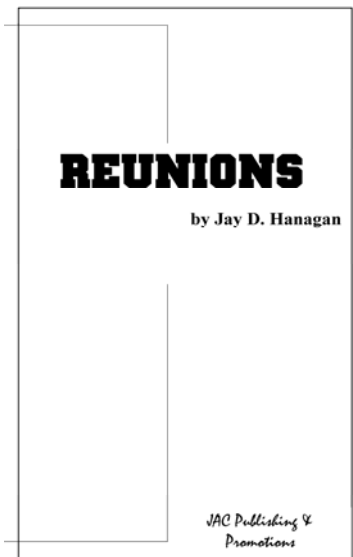


Three new plays from Jay Hanagan!
